



Search Courses

# **Enrollment Requirements**

- Full-time status: 12 units
  - We suggest students enroll in 15-16 units each semester (4 courses)
- Minimum progress: Students must complete at least 24 units each academic year
- Normal Progress: Students are expected to complete their degree within 4 years (8 terms)



# Add/Drop Deadlines

- Last day to add classes online: January 23rd
- Last day to add classes (instructor permission): February 6th
- Last day to drop classes online: February 6<sup>th</sup>
- Last day to withdraw from a course (with a "W" on transcript): April 4<sup>th</sup>

# **Building a Schedule**


- "Suggested Schedule by Major" on SSHA Advising website






### What do I Do Now?

### Tips while registering

- Register for your WRI and major intro course first!
- When using the "Suggested Schedules by Major", find your WRI placement, and select course in that column



- Enroll in MATH if your major is the following: ECON, MBE, COGS BS
  - Keep your MATH placement if your major is SOC and PSY
