What is the difference between Commencement and Graduation?

Undergraduates applying for <u>GRADUATION</u> need to have completed all degree requirements as recorded on the official transcript. Undergraduates applying for <u>Commencement</u> will be attending a ceremony that celebrates the completion of a degree. Participation in the <u>commencement</u> ceremony does not imply that you have officially graduated.

Please note, in order to participate in Commencement 2017, you must complete all degree requirements no later than Summer 2017.
