- 1. A completed Graduation Plan using MyDegreePath
 - a. Complete a graduation plan using Plan Builder via MyDegreePath. Your plan must include all of your <u>remaining</u> degree requirements.
 - b. Click <u>here</u> to watch a video tutorial on how to create a Graduation Plan.
 - c. You are expected to complete your graduation plan <u>before</u> meeting with your <u>Academic</u> <u>Advisor</u>.
 - d. Undeclared SSHA students should complete a Graduation Plan for their intended major within SSHA.
