Graduating in 2014? Important Guidelines

Where is the application located? Online through your Portal, only if you are eligible to apply (90 units earned).

Can I participate in Commencement ("walk") but finish degree requirements in Summer or Fall 2014? Yes, you can, but you need to make sure to apply for graduation during the term which you will complete degree requirements.

Deadline information:

Finishing all coursework in Spring 2014?

<u>The Spring 2014 Graduation Application is CLOSED</u>. You can now only apply for Summer or Fall 2014 graduation. Apply for graduation <u>now</u> – <u>April 1, 2014</u> to ensure you can participate in Commencement.

Finishing all coursework in Summer 2014?

- Apply for graduation <u>now April 1, 2014</u> to guarantee participation in Spring Commencement
- The last day to apply for Summer 2014 graduation is June 15, 2014

Finishing all coursework in Fall 2014?

 Apply for graduation <u>February 16 – April 1, 2014</u> to guarantee participation in Spring Commencement
